



## PRESENTERS CODE OF CONDUCT

### INTRODUCTION

To maintain Rose City FM high standards in terms of behaviour, interactions and professionalism, the following standards must be adhered to.

### STANDARDS

Presenters, members and guests must:

1. Always use appropriate language in the studio, especially on air. It is the presenters responsibility to remind and encourage all guests to do the same.
2. Maintain a positive attitude in regard to the station, programs or broadcast content. All members must refrain from making negative or derogatory comments about the station or its members.
3. Care for and respect all studio equipment including studio desk, computers, kitchen equipment and building.
4. Respect others' right to work in a safe and supportive environment. No inappropriate signage or 'jokes' are to be displayed.
5. Maintain a professional ethical practice and refrain from making comments, especially on air, about personal views e.g. political views, religion.
6. Be responsible for your (or your guests) litter or mess and leave the studio in a clean and tidy manner. This includes all areas of the building.
7. Treat all listeners with respect, when on air or in social networking situations. Maintain a positive and professional approach during all interactions.
8. Follow all management or committee directives and decisions as stipulated. Any concerns or questions surrounding directives or decisions must be formally presented to the management committee in writing.
9. Familiarise yourself with all policies and procedures and recognise the stations' accountability to Australian Broadcasting bodies.
